## Symbols and digits - Games activity plan

## Description

A creative task, to allow learners an opportunity to practice writing digits and symbols in a relaxed and enjoyable format.

## Preparation

Print the colouring-in sheets - a selection per learner. Choose colour key and digit range for learners to use.
E.g. $£$ is red, $p$ is purple, 1 is blue, etc.

Prepare example, in your chosen colour key.

## Resources

Colouring-in sheets
Coloured pencils or coloured, fine-tip, handwriting pens Coloured board markers colours to match learners' pens or pencils

Vocabulary
$£$ (pound), p (pence),
1-10 (digits)

## Introduction/context

Introduce the colour key by writing on the board.
Ask learners to write the symbols or digits into the picture instead of colouring-in.
Offer completed example.
Remind learners to take their time with small neat digits and symbols.
