

# Symbols and digits - Games activity plan



### Description

A creative task, to allow learners an opportunity to practice writing digits and symbols in a relaxed and enjoyable format.

## Preparation

Print the colouring-in sheets — a selection per learner. Choose colour key and digit range for learners to use. E.g. £ is red, p is purple, 1 is blue, etc. Prepare example, in your chosen colour key.

#### Resources

Colouring-in sheets

Coloured pencils or coloured, fine-tip, handwriting pens

Coloured board markers — colours to match learners' pens or pencils

Vocabulary £ (pound), p (pence), 1-10 (digits)

#### Introduction/context

Introduce the colour key by writing on the board.

Ask learners to write the symbols or digits into the picture instead of colouring-in.

Offer completed example.

Remind learners to take their time with small neat digits and symbols.

Timing 5 mins	Introduction As above.
Timing 5 mins	Issue colouring-in sheets Issue a selection per table or have piles available to choose from at the front of the class.
liming 20-45 mins	Colouring-in time  Allow learners appropriate time to explore and vary their technique and approach.

#### Variations/expanding on the activity

The concept and colouring-in sheets can also be used for letter or word writing practice.
