



Preparation

Print and cut out the reflection cards.

Create three price signs (20p, 75p and £1).

Introduction/context

Following on from the previous career activity, highlight the importance of teamwork and communication for any career.

Outline the activity:

- Each group is given a hypothetical budget of £10 to buy materials to build their tower.
- The materials they can choose from are:
 - Sticks of raw spaghetti for 20p each, marshmallows for 75p each and elastic bands for £1 each.
- The group with the tallest free-standing tower and most remaining budget, wins.
- The teams will have time to design and plan before deciding how to spend their money.
- If they save some of their budget, they will get one more chance to buy additional resources halfway through the activity.

Resources

Raw spaghetti Marshmallows Elastic bands

Vocabulary Budget, teamwork, communication

Timing 15 mins	Design time Issue each team paper and pencils and allow them time to design their towers and decide how to spend their budget.
Timing	First build
20 mins	Allow learners time to try and put their designs into practice.
Timing	Rethink
5 mins	Ask learners to stop building and return to their designs. Allow them time to reconsider and purchase more materials if needed.
Timing	Final build
20 mins	Allow learners time to finish or rework their towers.
Timing 20 mins	Conclusion One group at a time, inspect the towers and review the remaining budget. Celebrate the winning team. Ask learners to complete the reflection cards. Once completed, ask the learners to look at the answers they have written and consider the skills in their team.
